Whereas, the Government of Meghalaya has constituted a Judicial Inquiry Commission, headed by Justice (Retd) B D Agarwal, vide Notification No. POL.36/2017/22 dated 11.04.2017, in exercise of powers conferred under Sub-section (1) of Section 3 of Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952, to enquire into the circumstances that led to the incident of police firing at Resu-Kaldang near Resubelpara in the North Garo Hills on 06.03.2017 resulting in bullet injury to three persons. The Commission has further been requested to determine whether the police firing was justified and any other matter that appears to the Commission to be relevant.

Accordingly, the Inquiry Commission invites Written Statements/Memorandums from individuals, injured persons, members of the victim families, NGOs and voluntary organizations, who are acquainted with the incident and willing to assist the Commission to come to a reasonable and logical conclusion to answer the terms of reference, formulated by the Government.

The individuals and voluntary organizations are requested to submit their Written Statements/Memorandums in the office of the Commission situated in the Circuit House on or before 08.12.2017 (Friday) before 10.30am.

The Written Statements/Memorandums shall be supported by Affidavits and documentary or visual/audio evidence, if any, in the possession of the person executing the affidavit.

The next sitting of the Commission will be held on 08.12.2017 (Friday) at 11.00am.
